Key takeaways on association code adoption

- 1. Rapid progress of new codes is naturally slowing, as there are fewer associations left without a code
- 2. Some associations are still reluctant or face other barriers to code adoption
- 3. At least 15 biopharmaceutical associations in the APEC region remain without a code or commitment

- 3. Member Company Adherence










MEXICAN CONSENSUS FRAMEWORK BY 2018
